Having spoken with many employers since the start of the Coronavirus crisis, it became clear that due to recent changes, whilst some companies are struggling to hit deadlines due to their teams being at home, having to look after children and relatives, other companies are finding their projects shelved or cancelled, meaning that development teams have spare capacity. We felt we could help by bringing together those companies that have need, with those that have resource, to support businesses through these challenging times.

We have created Corriculo Labour Exchange to be a 'market-place' where companies that have development or resource capacity to spare, can sell that capacity to companies that still have a demand for it.

How does it work?

If you're a company that finds yourself either with spare resource, or in need of a little extra, then get in touch. We've tried to think of the simplest solution to collect information in order to match up resource quickly and effectively.

For companies looking to sell capacity, you need to contact us with the details of the person/s that they have available, please make sure to include their:

- Skill set and experience level.
- Available time and any constraints.
- Cost.

For companies needing some additional resource, simply email us at Corriculo with details such as:

- An outline of the project/work required
- An expectation of the number of hours required
- The skills/technologies required
- A deadline

What skills does Corriculo Labour Exchange cater for?

The most common skills exchanged so far have been within development, testing and database administration, but whatever you have, or whatever you need, we'll do our best to find a match for you.

What are the benefits?

For those companies who need extra development capacity Corriculo Labour Exchange is an excellent idea because:

- + Your project may not have enough to warrant hiring a full time, permanent developer, nor might you feel confident doing so in the current climate.
- + There is no need to interview & assess to the same extent as you would with a contractor.
- + You get to use people from companies you know, whose reputation you're aware of and with whom you'll be able to continue liaising in the future.
- + It's cheaper and easier for short-term needs.

For those companies with capacity to "sell", it's an excellent opportunity to:

- + Collaborate with other local companies in the local business community.
- + Generate some extra revenue, and keep Development teams fully-utilised.
- + Give your team the chance to broaden their experience on different projects.

What does it cost?

What companies charge for the labour they wish to sell is up to them, but our suggestion is that the seller calculate the day rate of the employee/s in question based on their salary, before adding a margin of 10%. Corriculo charges an introduction fee to the buyer, of 10% of each transaction.
